- Letter of Recommendation





Vancouver Academy of Dramatic Arts (VADA) High School Scholarship Requirements

To be considered eligible, Applicant must be:

- Canadian Citizen, Permanent Resident or Landed Immigrant
- Graduating in the current high school year at time of applying
- Have completed at least (3) years of English study at a Canadian high school
- Have completed at least (2) years of Acting, Drama or Theatre class during high school

Application must be accompanied by:

- **Copy of Official Photo ID**
- **Copy of high school transcripts (Interim or Final)**
- **250 Word Essay:** Discussing **a) Why would you like to study Acting for Film & TV? b) Why have you chosen Vancouver Academy of Dramatic Arts (VADA) to pursue your studies?**
- **Letter of Recommendation** from a Dramatic Arts Instructor or Career Counsellor

Note:

- All scholarship applications will be assessed by VADA's Scholarship Committee.
- Scholarship awards may **only** be applied toward tuition for the full time **Dramatic Arts Program Diploma** and may **not** be exchanged or redeemed for cash or credit.
- Scholarship will be awarded once a candidate has successfully applied for and been accepted into Vancouver Academy of Dramatic Arts (VADA).
- Scholarship awards of up to **\$500 (CDN)** will be awarded based upon the completion and content of all **required scholarship requirements**

Application Deadline: Application for High School Scholarship **must** be received by **August 1st** of an applicant's final year of high school.

Scholarship award is valid for (1) year from the date of issue.
Scholarship Award may not be used toward part-time study courses.

Additional Financial Aid Options

Government Financial Aid (Student Loans)

- **Must be Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident or Landed Immigrant to qualify**
- Does not require co-signer
- No payments required or interest accrued while studying
- Loan repayment begins 6 months after graduation (interest starts accruing after last day of class).
- Interest rate approximately 5% (as of December 1, 2016)
- Not required to repay loan until earning at least \$25,000 per year*
- *See Repayment Assistance Program

Government Grants available:

- **Must be Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident or Landed Immigrant to qualify**
- \$2,000 to \$3,000 per year for full-time students from low-income families;
- \$800 to \$1,200 per year for students from middle-income families;
- \$800 to \$1,200 per year for part-time students from low-income families

Scholarships

- VADA awards scholarships of between \$0 - \$2,500*

*For use toward Vada's Dramatic Arts Program Diploma only. May not be exchanged or redeemed for cash.

Student Line of Credit

- **Must be Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident or Landed Immigrant to qualify**
- Requires co-signer (usually parent)
- Interest only payments required while studying
- Start repaying principal amount borrowed 6 months after program completion
- Negotiate own timetable for repayment
- Low interest rates (between 2 - 4%)

Monthly Payment Plans

- Available for Domestic & International Students
- Students can have a monthly payment plan created for school
- Payments must be completed 30 days before program completion

Note: There is a \$10 administrative fee required for each payment of payment plan

NOTE

If a student completes an **Intro to Acting Certificate OR On Camera Intensive Certificate**, then decides to enrol in our full time **Dramatic Arts Program Diploma**, the cost of their Certificate program **will be deducted from the tuition fee** of their Dramatic Arts Program Diploma.
